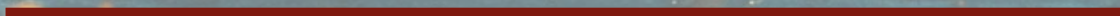

# FROM THE PRESIDENT | DENNIS ALM



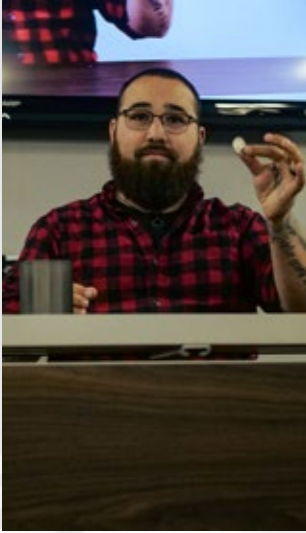

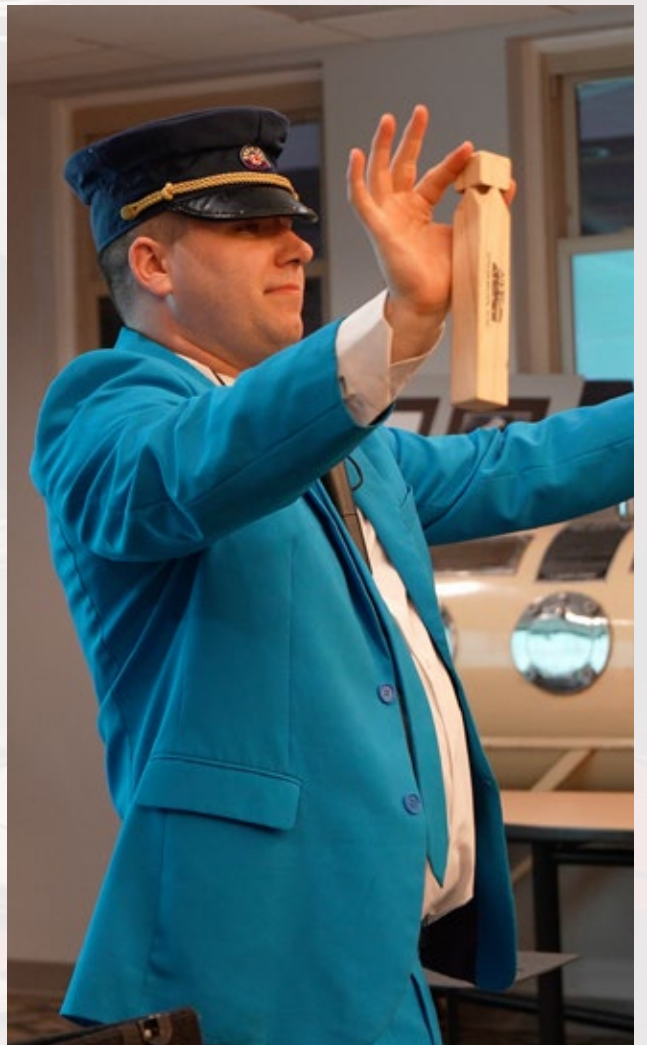
