Coming in August we'll have our annual LMC picnic on Saturday, August 10 and we'll have information about the picnic available at our July 12 meeting.

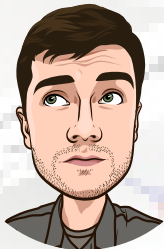
Later in the month of August, we host a lecture by Nathan Coe Marsh on Wednesday, August 28.
