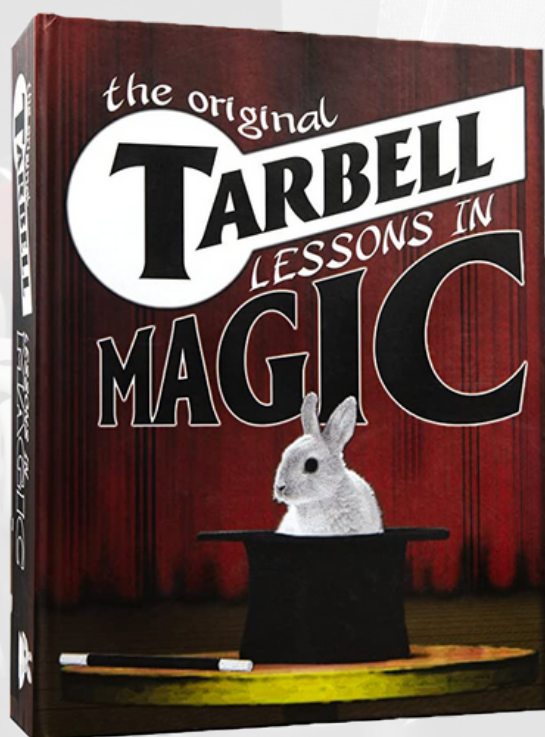
Study and Practice
