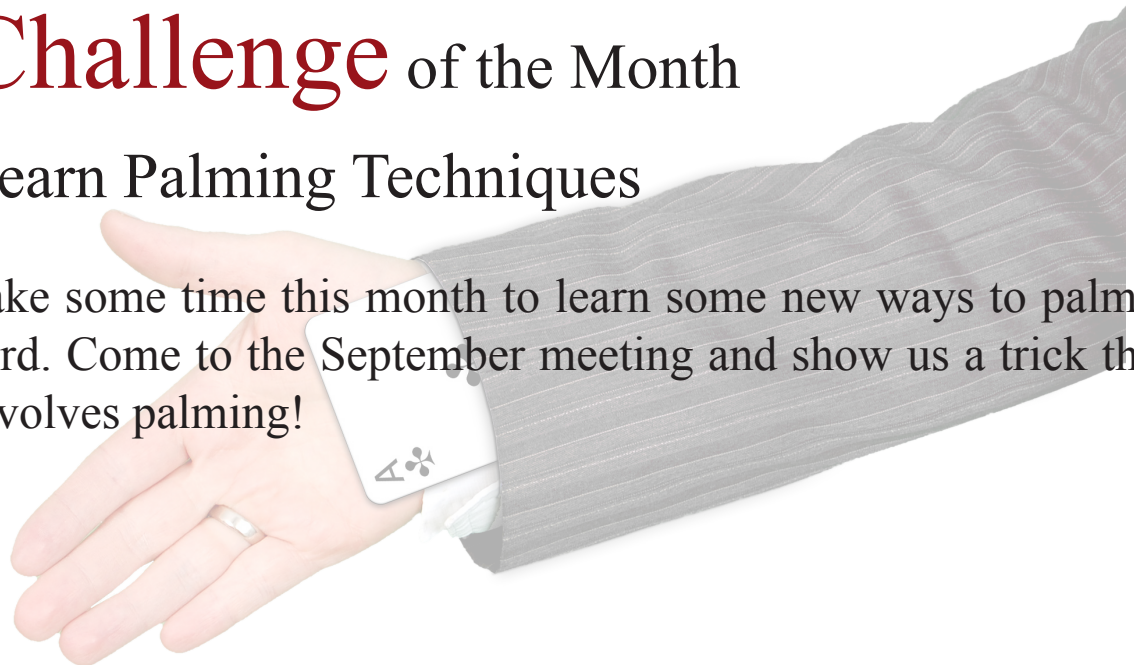
Matt Fore Lecture
