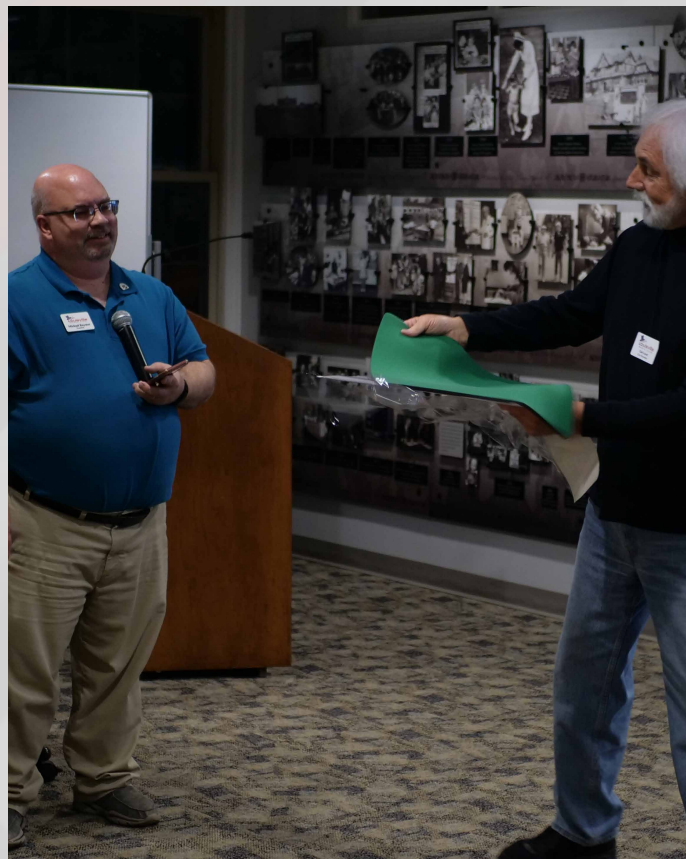


J&B Magic Shop and Theater
